Wednesday, June 19: Mr. Bart Linssen, General Manager ENABL A/S Taiwan

Mr. Linssen has spent over 20 years in the renewable energy sector, most recently at ENABLE A/S and ENERCON, both global leaders in wind energy. He specializes in service operations the development of custom solutions to meet the needs of diverse clients in Taiwan and other regions. His mission is to promote renewable energy as an environmentally and economically viable alternative to traditional energy sources.

Mr. Linssen was born in the Netherlands and received a master's degree in Electrical Engineering from the Eindhoven University of Technology. He has been living in Taiwan since 2000, is married, and has a daughter.

Thursday, June 20: Dr. Lin-Chi Chen, Deputy VP for Academic Affairs Director, Center for General Education Professor, Department of Biomechatronics Engineering National Taiwan University

Dr. Chen's does research in Biosensors and Biochips, DNA-based Artificial Antibodies, and Electrochemical Devices. Since joining the NTU faculty in 2005, he has won numerous awards for his teaching and research. At the core of Dr. Chen's philosophy is an interdisciplinary approach to teaching and learning that transcends traditional departmental boundaries. He has used his office as an administrator to promote forward-looking practices, including cross-field learning/teaching designs, university-level interdisciplinary study programs, the use of on-line digital platforms for on-campus and off-campus learning, and EMI (English as a Medium of Instruction) to internationalize students and faculty.
